This 56' general service tank car is painted SP dark lark grey, with red ends and side wings, and is lettered in white. It was serviced in May 1974 and runs on Barber[®] roller bearing trucks. This was SP's first and only experiment with the tank car fuel tender concept. SP 700 was not successful with the five modified GP40-2s that ran with this tank car and were subsequently placed back into the freight pool.

This 89' 4" COFC flat car is painted red with white and black lettering. It runs on Barber[®] roller bearing trucks. Built by Hawker-Siddeley Trenton in July 1975, this car is outfitted with special bolsters for overhead loading of containers. It is able to carry either two 40' or four 20' intermodal containers and is equipped with end-of-car cushioning

This 50' rib side box car with single door and no roof walk is painted maroon with yellow herald and yellow and white lettering. It was built in March 1974 and serviced in September 1998. This car runs on Barber[®] roller bearing trucks. Wisconsin Chicago Link Ltd. (WCCL) is one of several consolidated subsidiaries under the Wisconsin Central Transportation Corp. holding company, hence the WCCL reporting mark.

This black 30' skeleton log car carries a varied log load. It has brass tie-down chains, a peacock brake wheel, runs on black Arch Bar trucks and is typical of the log cars used on standard gauge railroads across the United States.

Northwestern Oklahoma Railroad Road Number NOKL 725035



This 61' 8" bulkhead flat car is painted green with white lettering. It was built in April 1975 and carries a pipe load on Barber® roller bearing trucks. The Northwestern Oklahoma Railroad Co. (NOKL), located in Woodward, is a shortline that has been running in Oklahoma since 1973. The company was founded in February 1973 and operated five miles of track abandoned by the MKT in 1972.

USS Argonaut Navy Series #8 Road Number SS-166



On 10 January 1943 while on patrol, Argonaut spotted a convoy of five freighters and their destroyer escorts. Argonaut hit at least one of the destroyers with her torpedoes, and they promptly counterattacked. It became apparent that a depth charge had severely damaged the submarine. The destroyers continued circling Argonaut and pumping shells into her. She slipped below the waves and was never heard from again. Her name was struck from the Navy list on 26 February 1943.

This 51 ft. 3/4 in rib side mechanical reefer is painted aluminum with black lettering. It was built by Pacific Car & Foundry in July 1964 runs on Barber® roller bearing trucks. This particular class RPL reefer comes equipped with adjustable Equipco loading or stowing devices and Hydra-Cushion underframe.

CSX Transportation® Road Number CSXT 254238



This three bay ACF covered hopper with elongated hatches is painted DuPont HS beige with large blue CSX herald and black lettering. It runs on Barber® roller bearing trucks. Built in August 1974 by ACF industries, this car was repainted in January 1994 by an outside contractor. (By this time the railroads were not allowed to paint their own freight cars).

NEW**Canadian Pacific
Road Number CP 165181**

This 40' box car with plug door is painted 'action yellow,' a color used for insulated cars, with a black and white 'multimark' logo and black lettering. It was built in December 1962, serviced in April 1987, and runs on Bettendorf trucks. In June 1968, Canadian Pacific introduced a new corporate image for their entire company. Freight cars were painted in solid colors by type: 'action yellow' for insulated cars and cabooses; 'action green' for newsprint; 'action red' for general merchandise boxcars, gondolas and flat cars and 'action silver' for refrigerator cars. The uniquely designed 'multimark' consisted of a circle segment and a triangle. In 1988, CP Rail stopped applying the multimark when repainting freight cars.
